3 reasons Blessed Sacrament is important to me.

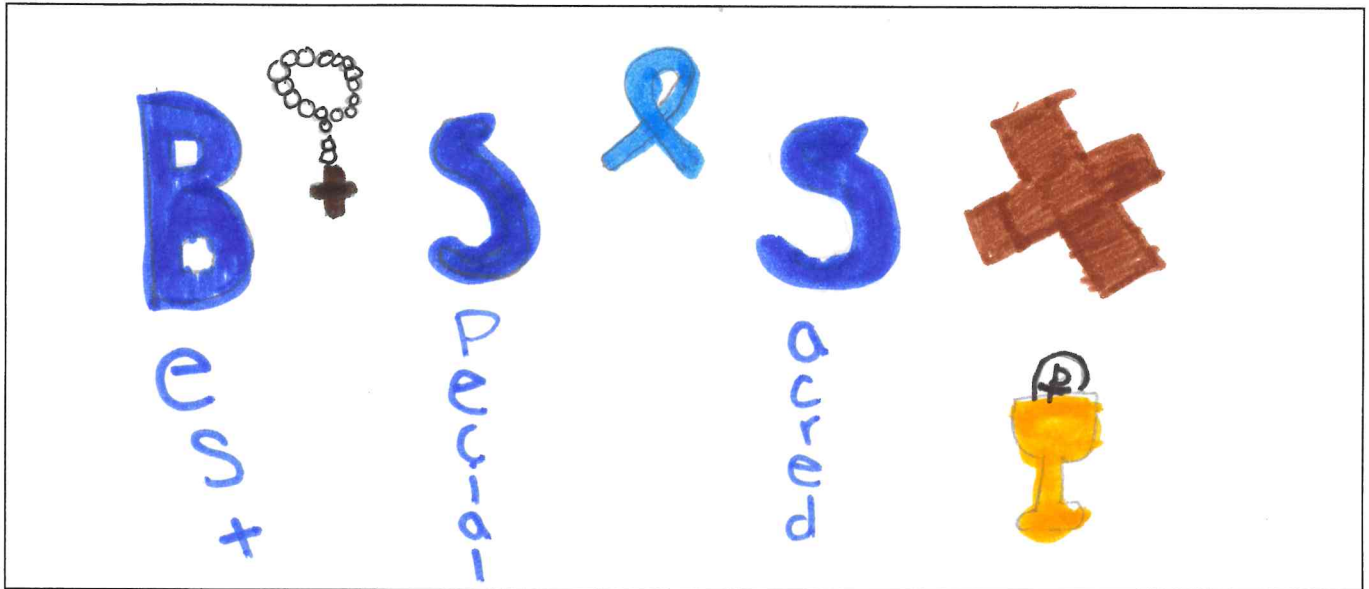
The 1st reason is because it's a catholic school. That's important to me because my family believes in God and the Holy Family.
