# Centennial Fun Fact

When the cornerstone was laid for the new church in 1938, it contained a metal time capsule.

On the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the building of the church, the cornerstone was temporarily removed and the capsule opened. It turned out that it contained only old newspapers.

Several weeks later, the cornerstone and time capsule were reinserted where they remain today.
