A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

The SRO Contract for Blessed Sacrament has been signed! God is good! We should have a definitive start date next week, but expect it will be the first or second week of February. Thank you again for your support and prayers!

We had 41 families come to visit during our Open House. In addition, I continue to have tour requests each day. Thank you to those Student Council students and parents who volunteered their time to lead tours. I also want to thank the following organizations for sharing their information with the prospective families in the gym: Boosters, Parent Club, Learning Grove, and the Blessed Sacrament Parish. Lastly, I want to thank Margo Baumgardner and the Development Committee for supporting this big event.

We are planning on some changes to our uniform for next year. We want to make the uniform “more uniform.” Before I go into the changes, please know that there will be a one year grace period before these changes are required.

- One jumper option: the V-neck jumper
- One skirt option: the multi-pleat option. Both the V-neck jumper and the multi-pleat skirt have the same plaid
- Navy pants for grades K-6
- Khaki pants for grades 7-8
- When wearing the navy pants, light blue polo shirts will be worn
- When wearing the jumper or skirt, white polo shirts will be worn (no requirement for school logo)
- Navy polo shirts with school logo for grades 7-8

I know it's a little early for school uniform shopping for 2026-2027, but wanted to share these changes now for your planning purposes.

**Subject: Availability of Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA)
Asbestos Management Plans**

Dear Parents, Teachers, and Staff:

In accordance with regulations of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet (EEC), we are required to notify parents, teachers and other employees each year of the availability of the Asbestos Management Plan (Management Plan) and the response actions we are taking to maintain asbestos containing materials in our school.

An updated Management Plan has been prepared for the school to ensure the proper maintenance and responses for asbestos-containing materials or suspect asbestos-containing materials. Appropriate response actions have been and will be taken to ensure the asbestos is maintained in good condition.

A periodic surveillance of the school has occurred every six months since the original inspection. Additionally, formal re-inspections were completed every three years since the original inspection. Copies of these reports are on file in the main office of the school.

Custodians and maintenance workers have been instructed on the health effects of asbestos and the importance of maintaining this material in good condition during their normal day-to-day activities.

No asbestos abatement activities are scheduled at this time.

If you wish to review the Management Plan, a copy is located in the school office.
