Dear Parents,


We are happy to report that things are seemingly, yet slowly, stabilizing for us and our school. While we still have a number of students quarantined due to travel or close contact situations, the number of students quarantined from testing positive has been halved from last week to this week. With everyone's continued adherence to the protocols and vaccinations around the corner, we are hoping that this most recent spike was the last. It is going to take a strong continued effort to eliminate disruptions to in-person learning, but things are seemingly on that path and we appreciate your help and support moving forward.

Read on for some updates:

- A) Updated COVID Reporting
 - a. Cases within the school, but not within your children's grade-level, will be reported via the weekly newsletter. Close contact situations and cases in the grades of your children will still be reported directly via e-mail. Thank you for your understanding.
 - Currently, 58 students are quarantined. 9 students are quarantined because of a positive test. The remainder are quarantined because of travel or as a close contact.
 - c. Many of our students that tested positive have since returned, and we have seen fewer students testing positive this week, which is encouraging. Please continue to do what's necessary to keep our kids and community safe.
