□ Updated COVID Reporting

- Currently, there are 28 students quarantined. Six of those students have tested positive. The remainder are a result of close contact or travel.
- Our numbers mirror the state and national trend where case numbers are dropping. We are so thankful for everyone working with us to continue to work through the situation and prevent the spread when possible. Thank you.

□ Valentines

- Students are allowed to bring in Valentines for their classmates! We are asking students to bring in a bag/box for the collection of Valentines as well as their Valentines cards by Tuesday, 2/9. This way, the valentines will sit for at least 72 hours before teachers distribute them to the students. If any candy is included with Valentines, ensure it is pre-packaged, not homemade, and peanut free.

☐ Education Opportunity Accounts

- Education Opportunity Accounts utilize voluntary, private donations of citizens to award needs-based funding to eligible families to provide them with educational opportunities that they may not otherwise have. Funding can be tailored to a student's specific needs and used for K-12 public and non-public school tuition and fees, online learning programs, tutoring services, therapy programs, transportation to and from school, and more.
- House Bill 149 (Education Opportunity Accounts) is on the move! Please call 1-800-372-7181 for the state legislative message line and the operator will leave a message for your State Representative based on your home address. You can also email by clicking here. Ask your State Representative to make sure HB 149 is passed out of committee as soon as possible and that they vote for the bill when it reaches the House floor. Families are depending on them to bring educational choice to Kentucky!

☐ Lunch Program & Title Funds

Our school benefits from families who apply, qualify, and accept free/reduced lunch benefits. Schools receive Title I funding (state funding) based on our free/reduced lunch numbers and it appears that this data will also be used to determine funding from the most recent Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA Act). To apply for these benefits for this current year, please go to the Diocese of Covington website (https://covdio.org/schools/school-food-services/) and complete an online or paper application. 
□ Vaccination



The dollars generated by this campaign do not disappear into the ether; they go directly back into the school to improve it within the next year.




