During his law enforcement career, he served as a Patrol Officer, supervisory and middle management ranks, Florence SWAT (Tactical) Team member, Detective, federal and state grant writer, and Police Chief for the City of Elsmere.

Spec. Maier holds a bachelor’s degree from the University of Findlay, criminal justice major, and a Master’s in Justice Administration from the University of the Cumberlands. He is a 2003 graduate of DOCJT’s Academy of Police Supervision and a 2004 graduate of Northwestern’s School of Police Staff and Command.
