Stay home.
Receive a negative COVID test OR an alternate diagnosis from a physician

RETURN TO SCHOOL AND remain symptom-free for 24 hrs. without medication.

Not yet tested for COVID
OR no alternate diagnosis from a physician,
OR not yet symptom-free for 24 hours.

Remain home while symptomatic. ISOLATE and follow physician's guidance. Communicate information to the school.

COVID-19 symptoms include: fever (above $100.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ ), chills, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea and a new, uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing.

"Close contact" is defined as an individual within 3 feet of someone who has COVID for a total of 15 minutes (cumulative) over the previous 24 hours.

The CDC now considers those who are "fully vaccinated" as having the booster vaccine, completed the 2 dose series of Pfizer or Moderna within the last 6 months, OR completed the J\&J vaccine within the last 2 months.
