

We need YOU!

Parents club's largest annual fundraiser is the Ladies Fall Event (LFE). This event generally raises \$10-20k in support of various parent club funded programs for the school to benefit students, teachers, and parents. We currently do not have a chair(s) for the 2024 event which is typically held in the November. This would be a great opportunity to gather 3-4 friends and plan a fun party for the Ladies of BSS! Creativity is welcomed! Parent Club has a structure/framework to build on and is just ready for your theme and creative spin.

This event is the largest source of revenue for Parent Club to fund the following expenditures:

Staff appreciation week	2,000
8th grade trip	1,750
Catholic school's week	2,500
Teacher \$200/each stipend at beginning of year	7,000
School stipends for teachers	13,500
Supplies and equipment for teachers	3,500

What will happen if we do not find a chair(s)? We will have to cut costs and may not be able to fund all of the programming and events for the teachers, students and parent that we have in the past. If we do not secure chairs by May 1st, we will have to cancel this event for the 2024-2025 school year.

What is the ask? The chair(s) would coordinate a date (typically held in the undercroft to save overhead), coordinate the LFE raffle, décor, food, beverages, games, entertainment, raffle baskets. A committee is formed (led by the chairs) which will assist in various pieces of the event planning process! Parent Club is also there to support/assist. 
