A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

In the fall, our 8th graders participate in a program run by Children's Hospital in Cincinnati: Adapt for Life. As part of the program, they discuss different mental health topics over four days such as anxiety, depression, suicide, stress, and wellness. Following this program, one of our students reached out to Mrs. Gastright and me to discuss her concerns and interest in providing support and awareness for our students. Mrs. Gastright then met with a larger group of 8th grade students who were interested in doing more on this topic. Mrs. Gastright applied for a grant through the Joe Burrow foundation and was in fact awarded the grant! This past Monday, our 8th graders celebrated Teen Mental Health Day by providing information and resources for our junior high students. One of their concerns is that teenagers are not aware of the resources to help those who are struggling in our community.

I wanted to share this as one example of our students reflecting on their learning and taking action. This resulted in a large group of students participating in the effort, and then even more getting more information and reminders of what they learned about in the fall, maybe at a time when they really needed it. We are all working together to form our students so that they can become disciples. This example is one story of them spreading the Good News of God's love for them through their caring and educating.




