# A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

Blessed Sacrament School is a PLC school. What does that mean? PLC stands for Professional Learning Community. Our faculty meets in a PLC twice a month on Tuesdays after school. Some teachers have two PLC groups as they teach two or more subjects. The PLC meetings are generally vertical teams for subjects such as ELA, math, science, social studies, and religion. The specialists also meet during this time.

The three foundational concepts of PLCs are: Focus on Student Learning, Driven by Results, and Collaborative Culture. This year, the science PLC has been exploring new textbooks because the series we have been using is being phased out. They have requested samples from different publishers, and examine the materials together. The religion PLC has been discussing how best to balance planned events so that our students experience personal encounters with Jesus while simultaneously maintaining our academic rigor and content in our core classes.

The primary work of PLCs is working on answering these questions:

- ☐ What do we want our students to learn?
- ☐ How do we know that they learned it?
- ☐ What will we do when they don't learn?
- ☐ What will we do when they already know it?

In order to answer these question, they look at data. We use MAP scores, DIBEL results, other assessments, as well as more subjective data such as the expression on their faces, their engagement, and their questions when presenting new material.

As you can see, the work of PLCs is critical to the success of our students! We believe that all students can learn at a high level. They do even better when parents partner with us to achieve high results. Thank you!
