## A Note From Your Administration

#### Good Afternoon, Everyone!

First and foremost, we want to recognize and thank our 1st grade teachers and students for their incredibly hard work planning, preparing for, and performing the Stations of the Cross last Friday. The students did an amazing job, and the teachers spent so much time carefully perfecting every detail to ensure the event was safe and successful! Our 8th grade students are working to do the same for their parents since they unfortunately missed this beloved event last year due to COVID. Join us in praying for them as they prepare!

#### Read on for additional updates:

#### **COVID Reporting**

- We currently have zero students quarantined as the result of a positive test. We currently have four students quarantined
- These numbers are extremely, extremely encouraging. All Diocesan schools are reporting similar numbers/trends. We can't say enough about how important this is to our community. Thank you!

#### **Spring Break & Travel**

- The Diocesan travel policy will stay in effect as written through spring break, regardless of vaccination status. That means if you are flying, traveling to a state where the positivity rate is above 15%, or visiting heavily-populated areas like amusement parts, you will need to quarantine upon your return. Quarantine duration is either 7 or 10 days. Please communicate the details of your travel to the office so we can update our records and provide guidance.
- Our last spike in cases came following the Christmas/New Year's holiday break. We sincerely want to avoid that same situation following spring break. Please do your part to keep our community safe and quarantine if necessary following travel! Thank you.

  Two guests per student may attend and COVID protocols must be followed (masks and spacing).


  Spring break begins Thursday, April 1, and we return to school on Monday, April 12.




