A Note From Your Administration

Good Afternoon, Everyone!

First and foremost, we want to recognize and thank our 1st grade teachers and students for their incredibly hard work planning, preparing for, and performing the Stations of the Cross last Friday. The students did an amazing job, and the teachers spent so much time carefully perfecting every detail to ensure the event was safe and successful! Our 8th grade students are working to do the same for their parents since they unfortunately missed this beloved event last year due to COVID. Join us in praying for them as they prepare!

Read on for additional updates:

1. **COVID Reporting**
 - a. We currently have zero students quarantined as the result of a positive test. We currently have four students quarantined as a close contact.
 - b. These numbers are extremely, extremely encouraging. All Diocesan schools are reporting similar numbers/trends. We can't say enough about how important this is to our community. Thank you!
2. **Spring Break & Travel**
 - a. The Diocesan travel policy will stay in effect as written through spring break, regardless of vaccination status. That means if you are flying, traveling to a state where the positivity rate is above 15%, or visiting heavily-populated areas like amusement parks, you will need to quarantine upon your return. Quarantine duration is either 7 or 10 days. Please communicate the details of your travel to the office so we can update our records and provide guidance.
 - b. Our last spike in cases came following the Christmas/New Year's holiday break. We sincerely want to avoid that same situation following spring break. Please do your part to keep our community safe and quarantine if necessary following travel! Thank you.
3. **Tuition Rates**

 - b. Note that we are transitioning from a three-tier model to a two-tier model to match our neighboring parishes. Please ensure that you read the explanation document by clicking on 'Tuition Rate Policy & Explanation' on the page linked above.
4. **Report Cards**

5. **Misc. Updates**
 - a. There is no bus service on Friday, March 19.
 - b. First Reconciliation is on March 23rd. Please pray for all children participating in this sacrament!
 - c. 8th grade Stations of the Cross is taking place in the church on Friday, March 26 at 12:15. Two guests per student may attend and COVID protocols must be followed (masks and spacing).
 - d. Spring break begins Thursday, April 1, and we return to school on Monday, April 12.
 - e. Registration for next school year is doing well! Thank you for spreading the word about our parish and school. If you know of anyone considering Blessed Sacrament, please have them reach out to us directly.
 - f. MAP scores will be sent home this week.

Lent - for a Change

Lent is a lot like spring training for the soul. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are less about giving up something than about gaining something greater. Athletes train to build strength and skill. They "give up" junk food, late hours, and laziness to attain a goal that they value more than those things. When we fast, pray, and give alms, we too have a goal: to build our spiritual awareness, to strengthen our will power, to pull ourselves out of well-worn habits of sin, and to ask God to forgive us, change us, and guide us back to him. We fast to free ourselves from the tyranny of the body.

This Lent, we must give up sin, lies and other traditions but not spiritual spring training. Below are a few suggestions. We have many more on our website: www.baby.org. May we encourage one another to make this a life-changing season.

RICE BOWL PROJECT

Jesus asks us to care for our sisters and brothers and to recognize him in them. The Catholic Relief Service Rice Bowl project gives us an opportunity to answer this Gospel call. What you give up for Lent changes lives.

Jesus shared our human condition, living in solidarity with us, knowing our struggles and suffering first hand. For six weeks, we can share some solidarity with our global human family. Eating one (or more) small, simple, meatless meals a week and placing the money we save in a "rice bowl" will give us a glimpse of what others experience daily, while providing the means to help them experience a little of what we take for granted. Keeping our global neighbors in prayer during this time will also help us grow in love, compassion, and gratitude.

You will find lots more information on our website, including world recipes for simple, meatless meals, weekly themes based on the Corporal Works of Mercy, stories of hope from countries served by the Rice Bowl Project, and even directions for making your own poster rice bowl.

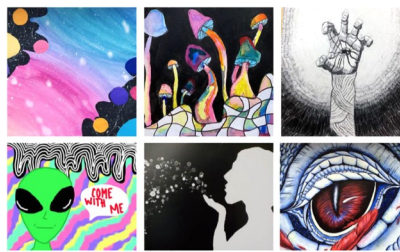

Whether it's outer space or personal space, express your feelings about this open ended prompt visually.

All works must be on paper. No frames or mats allowed. All artwork must be submitted through our online form to be considered. 100 works will be displayed in person, and all other qualifying works will be presented in a slideshow. Online submissions are due March 15. Please submit your artwork by clicking the link here. The Cincinnati Art Museum seeks to be inclusive in this exhibition. We will display all qualifying artworks submitted on a slideshow in the Great Hall during the Teen Art Expo. We will highlight 100 artworks that will be displayed in person during the exhibition. These 100 artworks will be selected by the 10x10 Team to showcase a variety of schools and ages. The 10x10 Team is a group of volunteer teen art enthusiasts from around the city, that is organizing this year's Expo.

Final artwork selections will be announced on March 23 via email. Artwork drop off will be specified in the announcement. If you have any questions, or did not receive an email, please contact programs@cincyart.org. Artwork will be displayed from May 6-9 at the Cincinnati Art Museum.
