He has been away since then to begin his studies to the priesthood in 1998 at a boarding school in New Hampshire. He has studied in Mexico, Connecticut, and Rome, earning degrees in Liberal Arts, Philosophy and Theology at *Regina Apostolorum*. He was ordained to the priesthood for the Legion of Christ December 10, 2016.

Fr. Andrew has experience in youth ministry running programs and working in schools in Washington DC area (7yrs) and Atlanta, GA (3yrs). His religious order has just reassigned him back in the Tristate area to support youth ministry here. He is very excited to be back serving in his native area and especially at his home parish. Fr Damian Hills has invited him, as a fellow son of the parish and school, to support at Blessed Sacrament.

He is supporting the school through his pastoral presence on campus. He also helps doing the 7pm mass on Sundays, server program, offering other formation opportunities such as Sports and Adoration, and supporting the Conquest program that meets on Sundays at 4pm.

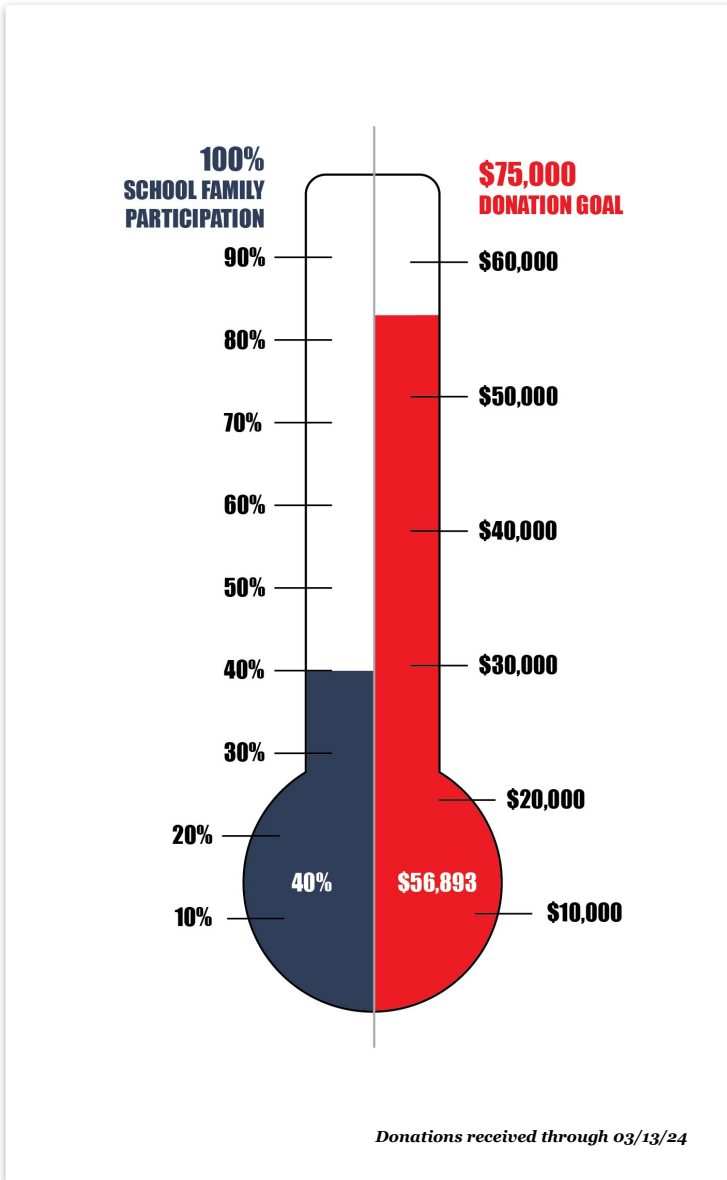
