Dear Families and Friends,



Many of our students learned about BSC's St. Vincent de Paul chapter during our Catholic Schools Week. Did You Know...

Our two junior high English teachers attended the KCTE LA Conference in March? Here are their thoughts:

"Mrs. Moorman and I were fortunate enough to attend a Kentucky Council of English Teachers conference at MSU two weekends ago. From learning how journaling can help release stress, how teachers can help students decode unknown or difficult vocabulary, and how students can see revising and editing an essay in a different light, the conference offered a variety of breakout sessions that informed us how we can ensure all voices in the school's community, both faculty and staff, can be heard. The keynote speaker was Kristen Simmons, author of the YA dystopian novel Article 5. Simmons shared with us how we can be inspired by others' stories, allowing us to get a glimpse into their lives. From these stories, similarities and empathy can be drawn. The conference and Simmons' speech reassured me that many are in the same boat as me, whether a teacher or student. We must be willing to share our stories when we get that feeling in our stomachs that the time is ripe and ready for the taking. We spent two long, arduous years during COVID receding into our shells – it is time for us all to continue moving forward into the sunlight together and retelling our stories to rekindle the fires of compassion and humanity inside of us."


