A Note From Your Administration

Dear Families and Friends,

Life is full of beginning and endings, of firsts and lasts. Jesus knew it was His last supper with the disciples. He loved us so much that he was willing to die for us so that when we die, we can go to Heaven and be with Him forever. At the Last Supper, He gave us the gift of the Eucharist. He knew we would need help along the way so that when it came our time to die, we would go to Heaven.

At the Last Supper, Jesus knew He was going to die, but the disciples didn't know. He wasn't thinking about His death, but about his disciples, including us, and what we would need. He gave us the Eucharist, and said, "Do this is memory of me" so that we could get the bread we need to make good choices. By attending mass each Sunday, we are reminded of God and His love for us. He knew we would need that reminder along our journey – that we wouldn't get to Heaven without it. Each week, we have the opportunity to reflect on our lives, on what we've done, and think about how we can improve in the week to come. We can dwell on Jesus' love for us, and be with Him through the Eucharist to strengthen us through the week.

The Eucharist is a powerful and amazing gift from our Savior to His disciples – to us. It is a beginning and an end at the same time. It is the end of us being alone, and the beginning of us being one body in Christ. So when you eat the bread and drink the wine, remember Him.






Thumbs Up for First Grade!

Our first graders blessed our school community with a beautiful presentation of the Stations of the Cross last Friday.




