#### A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

In January, we had three visitors from the Kentucky Center for School Safety tour the school to provide us with some feedback on our protocols here at BSS. On our recent in-service day in March, they came back to discuss with the faculty some of their observations. They complimented a couple of safety features: the morning drop off, registering of visitors collecting keys in exchange for lanyards, and the presence of a counselor and therapy dog among others. They encouraged all teachers to follow the law in Kentucky that doors are to be shut when the majority of students are in the classroom, and to have us close a couple doors in the building that have been open since COVID when we didn't want students touching door knobs/handles. If you have been in the building recently, you might have noticed this change. We are also working on creating some signs for some closets throughout the building though classroom signage is clear. They encouraged us to continue to work closely with Ted Edgington (SRO) and the Ft. Mitchell police department, and said we were fortunate to have them in such close proximity to our school.

I also wanted to remind everyone that students should be in the building by 7:15 so that they can be in their classrooms by 7:20. I think we've had some backsliding since the time change.

Lastly, I wanted to remind everyone that students can wear shorts starting next Tuesday, April 1 (not an April Fool's Joke). You might want to try on those shorts this weekend in preparation.


