# A Note From Your Administration

Good afternoon everyone!

We hope that you all had a restful and rejuvenating Spring Break. We are now officially in the “home stretch” of the 2020 – 2021 school year. While it has been a crazy journey, we are thankful for all of your support and especially for the hard work of our staff to ensure that this year was and remains as productive as possible. While we may be nearing the end, this trimester still has some exciting things to look forward to! Read on for updates:

## ❑ COVID Updates

- a. Currently, we have zero students quarantined as the result of a positive test and zero students quarantined as a result of close contact. We have 52 students out as a result of travel, the strong majority of which will return later this week or Monday.

## ❑ Sacraments & Notable Dates

- a. Confirmation Practice (for candidates only) is next Monday, April 19<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 – 8:30 PM at Blessed Sacrament Church.
- b. Confirmation is scheduled for Wednesday, April 21 and Thursday, April 22 at 7:00 PM at the Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption. Each family previously signed up for one of the two sessions.
- c. There is no school for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students only on Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> in celebration of their Confirmation.
- d. The first of three First Communion celebrations for our second grade students takes place Sunday, April 25<sup>th</sup>. The two additional celebrations are on Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- e. Graduation for our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students is on Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.
- f. Our last day of school for the school year is on Friday, May 28<sup>th</sup>.

## ❑ Virtual Instruction & Sick Days

- a. This week, virtual instruction is being implemented as a result of so many quarantined students. Starting next week, we wanted to ensure that the policy for sick days is clear.  
*Virtual instruction is not available during sick days unless otherwise specified by the grade-level teachers. As you can imagine, it is an incredible burden on teachers to manage both the in-person students and those participating virtually at home. While our teachers do so graciously when necessary, we avoid it when possible to allow full focus on our in-person students. For all grades (unless otherwise instructed by the teachers), sick days are handled as they were in the past. Work will be collected and sent to the office at the end of the day for you to pick up. In grades 5 – 8, mandated quarantine only will still be handled with virtual instruction. In grades K – 4, teachers will provide direction on work for mandated quarantine periods.*

## ❑ Other Updates & Reminders

- a. There is no bus service for the remainder of this week (KCSO Spring Break).
- b. Spring MAP testing begins on Monday, April 19. Grade levels will communicate specific dates.
- c. There is no school on Friday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, as there is a staff in-service.

We are happy to be back and anxiously look forward to next week when almost all of our students will be back in-person!

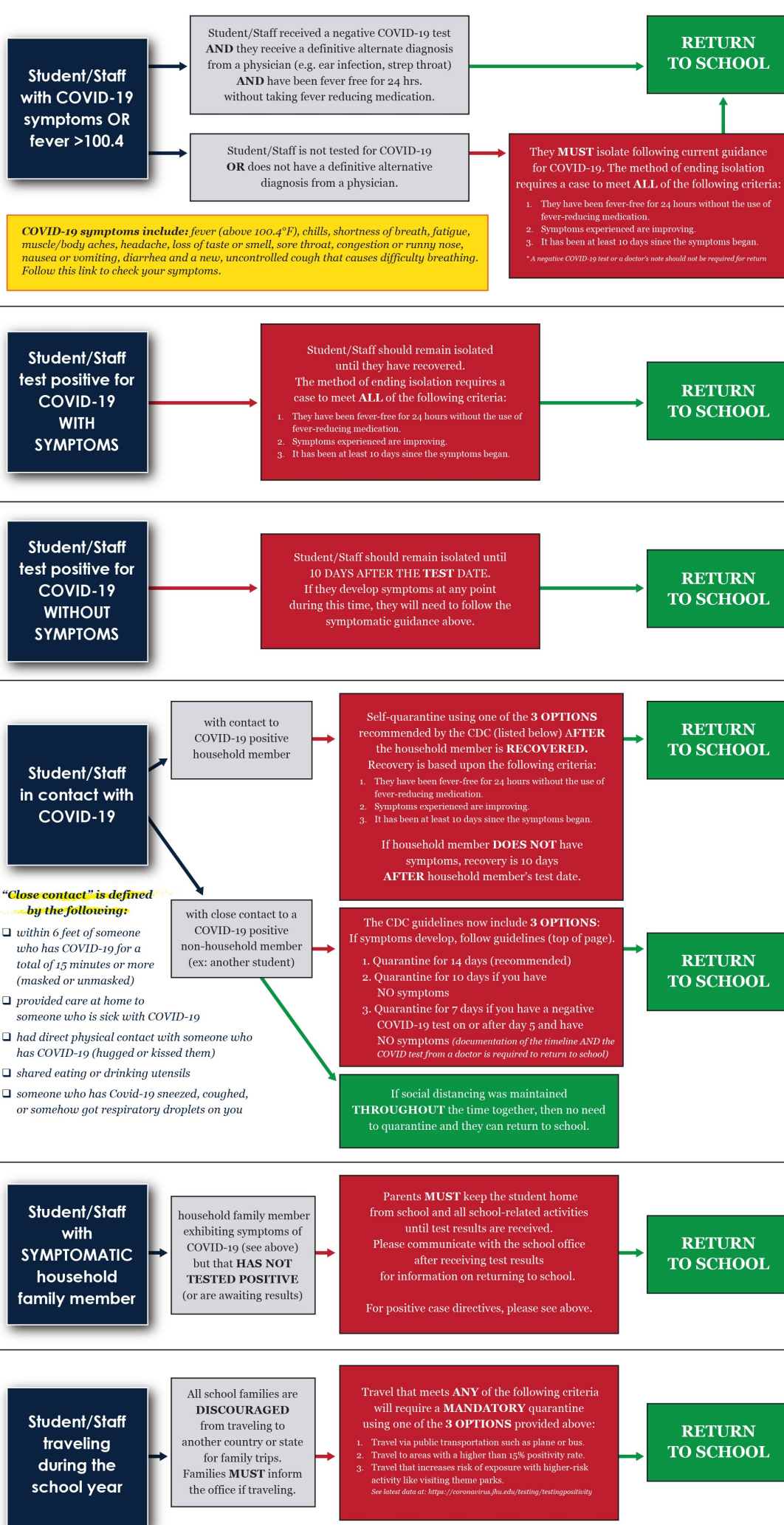

*Lent - for a Change*

Lent is a lot like spring training for the soul. Prayer, fasting, and Almsgiving are less about giving up something than about gaining something greater. Athletes train to build strength and skill. They "give up" junk food, late hours, and alcohol to train a goal that they value more than those things. When we fast, pray, and give alms, we too have a goal: to build our spiritual awareness, to strengthen our will power, to pull ourselves out of well-worn habits of sin, and to ask God to forgive us, change us, and guide us back to him. We fast to free ourselves from the tyranny of the body. This Lent, we must give up fish fries and other traditions but not spiritual spring training. Below are a few suggestions. We have many more on our website: [www.bdcy.org](http://www.bdcy.org). May we encourage one another to make this a life-changing season.

**RICE BOWL PROJECT**  
Jesus asks us to care for our sisters and brothers and to recognize him in them. The Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl project gives us an opportunity to answer this Gospel call. What you give up for Lent changes lives.

Jesus shared our human condition, living in solidarity with us, knowing our struggles and suffering first hand. For six weeks, we can share some solidarity with our global human family. Eating one (or more) small, simple, meatless meals a week and placing the money we save in a "rice bowl" will give us a glimpse of what others experience daily, while providing the means to help them experience a little of what we take for granted.

Keeping our global neighbors in prayer during this time will also help us grow in love, compassion, and gratitude.

You will find lots more information on our web site, including world recipes for simple, meatless meals, weekly themes based on the Corporal Works of Mercy, stories of hope from countries served by the Rice Bowl Project, and even directions for making your own paper rice bowl.
