A Note From Your Administration

Blessed Sacrament School receives donation of \$100,000 to support STEM and Science education.

William James Farrell, Sr., was a man of strong Catholic faith, supporter of education, and leader in his community. He mentored young people with wisdom and support. A generous donation has been made in his honor to Blessed Sacrament School by someone whose life he impacted.

Bill was a lifelong resident of Ludlow; educated at Saint James Elementary School and Covington Catholic High School. This led him to the University of Cincinnati College of Pharmacy. After graduation and service in World War II, he joined his father as a pharmacist at Farrell's Pharmacy, where he served his community until his death in 1986. William married Rachel Hood and welcomed five children: William (Bill) Farrell, Jr., Susan Farrell James, Father Thomas Farrell, Dan Farrell, and Michael Farrell.




