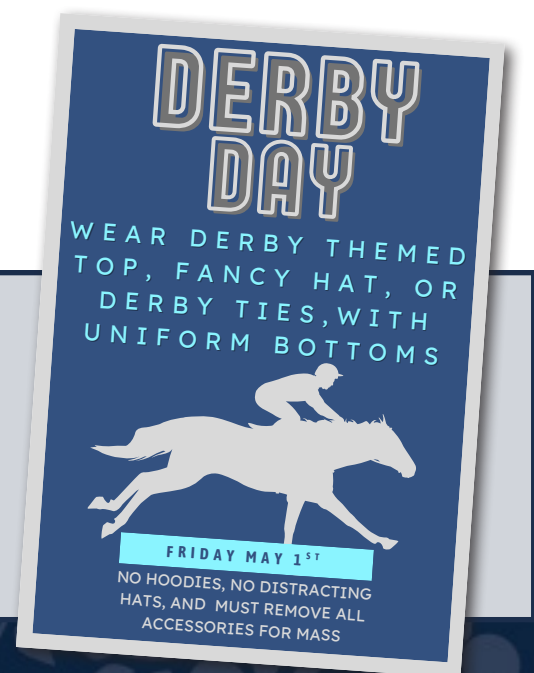
CONFIRMATION PRAYER

Summer Fun with Mrs. Ernst - incoming 2nd-4th grade students

This camp is a great way for younger students to get creative and try new things in the art room! We will complete three projects during this 4-day camp, including sculpture, weaving, and painting. We will be working on the same projects in each session, so please only sign up for one camp/student. These spots filled up QUICKLY last year, so I added a third session this summer - don't miss out! Due to time constraints, absences will not be rescheduled.

Drawing Camp - incoming 5th-8th grade students

- Monday, June 1 - Thursday, June 4 (10:30am-12:30pm)

This camp is geared toward older students who want to learn more about basic drawing as well as different techniques for adding color and dimension to their artwork. Students will be provided with a variety of subjects to choose from and will work to complete at least one drawing during this 4-day camp. Grid drawing, use of simple shapes to create complex forms, and a variety of shading techniques will be covered. Due to time constraints, absences will not be rescheduled.

Weaving Camp - incoming 5th-8th grade students

- Monday, June 15 - Thursday, June 18 (10:30am-12:30pm)

This camp is geared toward older students and will cover the basics of cardboard loom weaving. Students will be provided with everything they need to create at least one textile piece during this 4-day camp. Students who have already completed our 6th grade weaving project in class will have the option of creating a larger woven piece OR using a different loom structure for their project if they want to try something different. Due to time constraints, absences will not be rescheduled.

Sculpture Camp (incoming 5th-8th grade students)

- Monday, June 29 - Thursday, July 2 (10:30am-12:30pm)

This camp is geared toward older students and will cover the basics of sculpting. Students will use air-dry clay to create at least one piece of 3-dimensional art during this 4-day camp. Finished sculptures will be painted with acrylic paint. Students will be provided with a choice of subjects/ideas OR can bring their own subject to work from. To ensure that projects will be dry and ready to paint by the last day of camp, the size will be limited to 6" tall. Due to time constraints, absences will not be rescheduled.

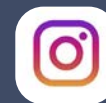
