PARENT CLUB EXECUTIVE BOARD OPENINGS

The BSS Parent Club has two open positions on the Executive Board for the 2021-2022 school year.

All board members are expected to attend monthly meetings with the school administration and evening meetings as scheduled throughout the year. In addition, attendance is expected at various school events throughout the year such as parent orientation nights, open house, and Parent Club fundraisers as needed.

All officers are selected from those that apply by a vote held among the current Executive Board with tiebreaker votes and final approval coming from the administration. Board members will hold their positions for 2 years. Brief descriptions of the duties specific to each open position are listed below. These duties are in addition to working with the board as a whole on Parent Club events.

Duties of Treasurer

Receive and disburse all monies of Parent Club directed by the board. Authorized check signer on the Parent Club bank accounts. Responsible for all monies collected at Parent Club-sponsored functions. Maintains and prepares budget for the incoming Treasurer for the next school year.

Duties of Bookkeeper

Serve as Treasurer-Élect. Will assume treasurer role after two years in bookkeeper position. Maintain a record of financial transactions for the school year. Balance all bank accounts monthly and prepare a brief financial statement for monthly Parent Club meetings.
