Dear Families and Friends,

RAISE THE ROOF! Good news! Father Hils has reached out to the parish community and has already raised \$160,000 for a new roof on the school! Also, any money raised by the parish in excess of the DPAA (Diocesan Parish Annual Appeal) will go directly to the new roof. Extra money raised in excess of the annual appeal does not get assessed by the Diocese, so it is a 1:1 donation to the roof. The total estimate for the roof is \$250,000, so we are well on our way. 
NEWS ALERT

BSS SUMMER ART CAMPS



Summer Fun with Mrs. Ernst (rising 2nd-4th graders)

Week 1: Monday, June 2 - Thursday, June 5, 11:30am-12:30pm in the BSS Art Room **WEEK ONE FULL!**
Week 2: Monday, June 9 - Thursday, June 12, 11:30am-12:30pm in the BSS Art Room
Cost: \$80/student (cash or check made payable to Annie Ernst)

Students will work with a variety of materials throughout this camp and will complete one guided project each day for a total of 4 projects by the end of camp. Each project can be completed within the one-hour camp, and additional smaller projects will be offered to students who finish their work early. Similar projects will be completed in week one and week two, so I ask that each student only sign up for one session. This also allows for more students to have the opportunity to attend. A peanut-free snack and drink will be provided each day.

Drawing Camp (rising 5th-8th graders)

Monday, June 2 - Thursday, June 5, 9:00 -11:00am in the BSS Art Room
Cost: \$160/student (cash or check made payable to Annie Ernst)

Students will work on a drawing project throughout this 4 day camp. Students can either bring something from home to work from (printed photo, object, etc.), or can select from project options that Mrs. Ernst has available in the art room. This camp offers many options for drawing mediums, including pencil, colored pencil, pen and ink, chalk pastel, and oil pastel. Students can choose to work with something they are familiar with, or learn something new. A peanut-free snack and drink will be provided each day.




Watercolor Camp (rising 5th-8th graders)

Monday, June 9 - Thursday, June 12, 9:00 -11:00am in the BSS Art Room
Cost: \$160/student (cash or check made payable to Annie Ernst)

Students will work on a watercolor project throughout this 4 day camp. Students can either bring something from home to work from (printed photo, object, etc.) or can select from project options that Mrs. Ernst has available in the art room. We will be using liquid watercolor paints, which are higher quality and produce more vibrant colors. Students can also choose to work with watercolor pencils, which combine the control of drawing with the beauty of watercolor. A peanut-free snack and drink will be provided each day.

Zentangle/Op Art Camp (rising 7th-8th graders)

Monday, June 16 - Thursday, June 19, 9:00 -11:00am in the BSS Art Room
Cost: \$160/student (cash or check made payable to Annie Ernst)

Students will work on a Zentangle OR Op Art project throughout this 4 day camp. Students can either bring something from home to incorporate into their project (printed photo, object, etc.) or can select from project options that Mrs. Ernst has available in the art room. Both zentangle and op art are methods that require patience and focus. Students will use rulers to keep their line-work precise, and will be able to choose to work in black and white or color. We will be working with Micron pens which produce excellent quality for detailed line work. This camp is only offered to rising 7th and 8th grade. A peanut-free snack and drink will be provided each day.
