This not only expedites the process immensely for the car line crew, it also prevents identification being requested. - □ Our first all-school Mass of the year is Friday. If you plan on joining, please remember that a mask is required despite vaccination status unless you have a medical exemption.
- Please remember to review the morning car line procedures. If it is at or after 7:05, you may use the bus driveway to drop off students. This route is supervised just like the car line. Using both lines helps alleviate congestion on Dixie Highway and ensures everyone makes it to school on time!


