A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

We had a great first full week of school! Hooray! Thank you to all who came to Curriculum Night. Our teachers' experience, faith and kindness are a key component in making Blessed Sacrament an exceptional school.

Now that we have had a little time to transition to the school-year schedule, we want to remind you that students need to be in the building by 7:15 a.m. That consistency is so important to start them off on the right foot so that they can "make it a great day!" Arriving to school on time is the best way for children to begin the school day. Time to get organized and be part of the morning routine of the classroom helps children start their day in a calm and comfortable manner.

We have modified our tardy policies in the handbook for this year:

- Students are expected to be in the building before the 7:15am bell
- Students arriving after 7:15am must report to the office for a tardy slip before going to the classroom
- Classroom teachers will notify parents/guardians once their child is tardy 5 times
- Administration will notify parents/guardians once their child is tardy 10 times, and a parent conference will be held to determine next steps

I understand there have been some questions regarding the school uniform. I did contact Schoolbelles to make sure they know that the V-neck jumper is still uniform-approved. When the weather gets colder, students may wear the regular short Ugg boot style, but not any shoes/boots that do now have a full backside to them, so no slippers or slides. I will highlight other aspects of the uniform in the next newsletter.


This fun-filled fundraiser supports capital improvements, teacher enrichment, and technology development—all vital investments in our school community.
