OUR SERVICE

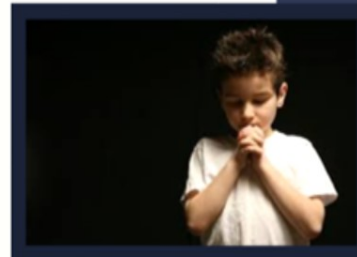


