A Note From Your Administration

Dear Families and Friends,

We had a great first week of school! Thank you for all your prayers for outdoor recess! They are working!

It was a blessing to have so many parents join us for the All School Mass last Friday. It was my first time with "The Circle Song," which is another example of our "All In!" theme for this year. We are "All In" the circle together as one body in Christ.

Yesterday, we had the pleasure of listening to the Southbank Quartet from the Immanuel School of Music perform for the 3rd-8th grades. They started out with the classical music of Mozart and Beethoven, moved to wedding and movie music, and ended with some video game music. They offer group lessons to our students in 3rd-5th grade, and private lessons to those in 6th-8th.

The COVID protocols for the 2022-2023 school year from the Diocese of Covington are included in this newsletter. Highlights include masks optional, positive COVID with symptoms are to stay home for 10 days, but can return if symptom free after 5 days (but need to wear a mask for those other 5 days), and continue to attend school if exposed with no symptoms, but wear a mask for 10 days. <u>Please note that the day COVID symptoms begin, or a positive COVID test result is received, is considered "Day Zero" of quarantine.</u> Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> for a detailed document from the Diocese of Covington.

I understand that car line can be long, especially in the first week of school, but please remember to be respectful of our neighbors. We had a complaint from a household on Virginia Avenue that parents were parking there, and having students listed as "walkers" so that they could walk to that street, and then be picked up. They warned us that their next step is to contact the police if it continues. Also, please remember that the front parking lot of school is not a designated pickup area, unless your child has stayed after school for an extra-curricular activity, tutoring, practice, or detention. Moving cars in the front parking lot during dismissal creates an unsafe situation for our students who walk home each day.

We are looking forward to seeing you tomorrow night at Curriculum Night which runs from 5-8 p.m.! Please read over the agenda carefully so that you're in the right place at the right time. It is attached <u>HERE</u> for your convenience.
