Thank you for keeping our community in your prayers.

As we are starting to see a handful of cases closer to and within our community, we felt it important to reiterate the quarantine protocols so that everyone is informed. We are working on an easy-to-use format for these protocols for everyone's reference. Additionally, protocols will likely continue to be updated. As always, we will communicate any changes or updates as they are made available to us.

Please keep the protocols below in mind as you decide what is best for your child. If you want us to be aware of and help remind your student to mask while at school, <u>please fill out this Google Form to inform us of your preference</u>. Again, masking is currently optional. As illustrated below, masking is one of the most effective ways to prevent quarantines and keep kids in school, which is our main priority. Thank you.

Close contacts are considered those individuals that were within 3-feet (in the school setting, 6-feet in the non-school setting) for a total of 15 minutes or longer over the 24-hours prior to symptoms/the positive test.

- □ Individuals who meet the criteria to be considered a close contact (above) are exempt from quarantine if:
 - A. They are masked OR
 - B. If they maintain 3-feet of space at all times OR
 - C. They were inside of 3-feet from the positive case for less than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period. OR
 - D. They are vaccinated
- □ Individuals who meet the criteria to be considered a close contact (above) <u>MUST quarantine if</u>:
 - They were unmasked
 - AND
 - B. They are not vaccinated

Regarding pending COVID tests:

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- □ For pending test results due to symptoms, siblings must also stay home until results are received.
- □ For pending test results as a result of a close contact/precaution, the tested individual must stay home, but siblings may still attend asheed unlass summtome orige in either the tested individual on the sibling
- but siblings may still attend school unless symptoms arise in either the tested individual or the sibling.

As of today, 4 students are quarantined due to a positive tests. 11 other students are quarantined due to pending tests or close contacts. Continue to conduct home health screenings and exercise caution by keeping your children home if they are experiencing symptoms.

If you ever have a question about a potential close contact or any other scenario on which you are unclear, please reach out to us. As we saw last year, the only way to prevent spread in our building is by working together to keep kids healthy and in school.


