A Note From Your Administration

Dear Parents,

As we approach the tail-end of our second week of in-person instruction, we again want to express our gratitude for the efforts of our staff, students, and community. Even our youngest students have proven their adaptability by being conscious of appropriate mask wearing, spacing, and hygiene habits. This is a direct result of our parents' guidance at home. Thank you and please keep up the reminders, coaching, and daily health screenings at home. Remember to follow the guidelines outlined in the Diocese's and our reopening plans, and, if you have any questions on protocols and mandates, do not hesitate to reach out to us. We are working on some one-page reference documents to help with clarity surrounding various scenarios, and we will share those with you when they are ready.

Our halls are alive with laughter and learning once more. Our classrooms and instruction look a little different, but the BSS community remains steadfast. We have learned to easily spot "smizing" (smiling with your eyes), and the joy of being together again is palpable in the building. We continue to pray that our year normalizes as we move forward, so that the essential parts of what makes BSS so special, such as parent volunteers, all-school Masses, plays, prayer services, and assemblies, can once again become a reality.

As we continue to keep educating ourselves on best practices and current information concerning the pandemic, we will communicate information we find pertinent as well as our efforts to address new concerns that arise. More and more research is being published that indicates that the virus can and is being transmitted through aerosols (exhaled, airborne particles that can travel further than droplets). The best way to combat that mode of transmission is fresh air, masks, and spacing. Please help us re-iterate the importance of these items, and have your kids help us by practicing them as often as possible.

With Labor Day weekend approaching, travel plans outside of the tristate may be planned. Please do so cautiously knowing that a 14 day quarantine may be required by the Diocese upon your return. It was mentioned to us yesterday that they are considering implementing a mandatory quarantine for any travel outside of the tri-state area, though nothing has been confirmed yet. We will let you know as soon as possible if that goes into effect. For now, refer <u>here</u> when planning travel. If there is a positive rate at or above 15% in the state while you are there, students must quarantine before returning to in-person instruction.


Thank you to Mrs. Frondorf for taking your language arts class outside for some fresh air this week!
