Using the PledgeStar App:

- Search for "PledgeStar" on your phone's App Store to download the Family App, or go to <https://pledgestar.com/BSS/downloadapp.html>
- On the home screen enter your event code: "BSS" to locate your event
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event"
- Enter your name and email address, then click "Submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Runner(s) and add family and friends

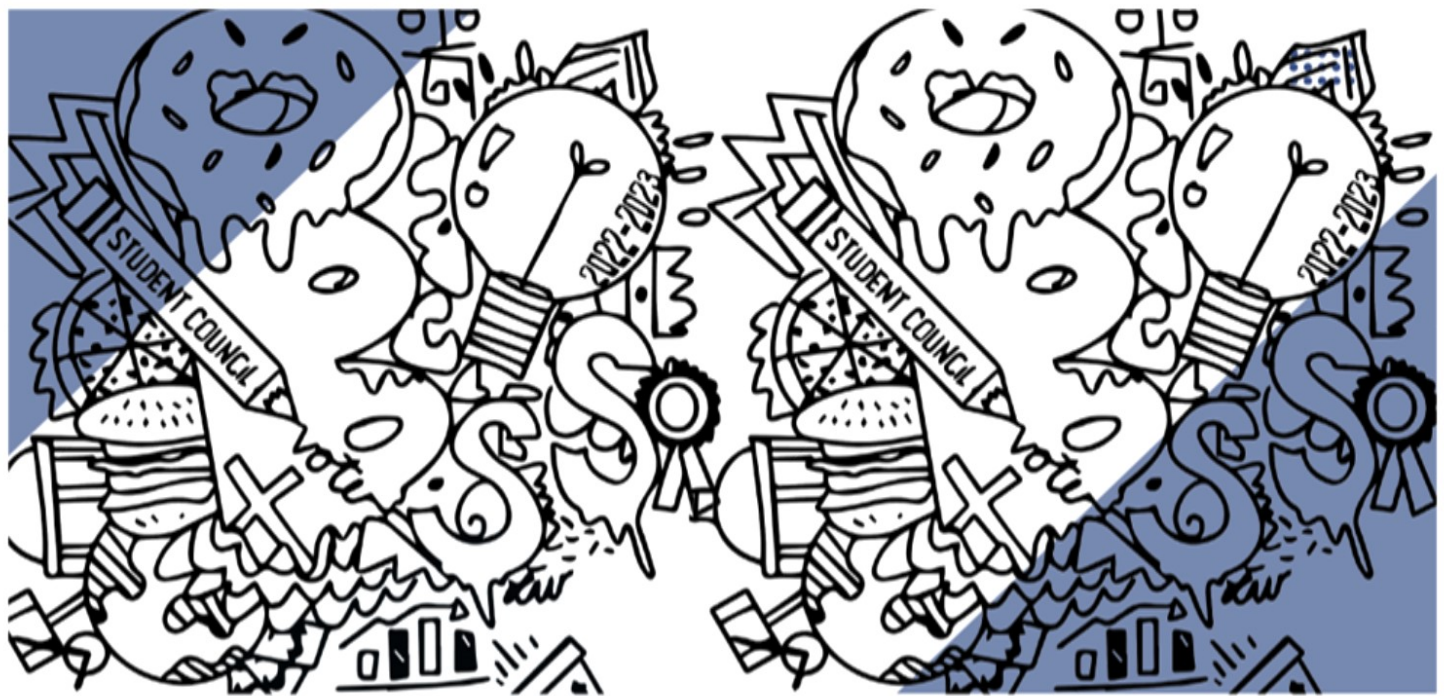

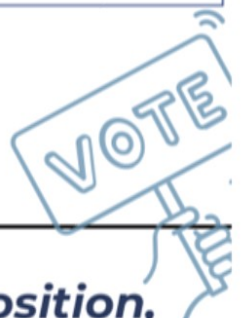

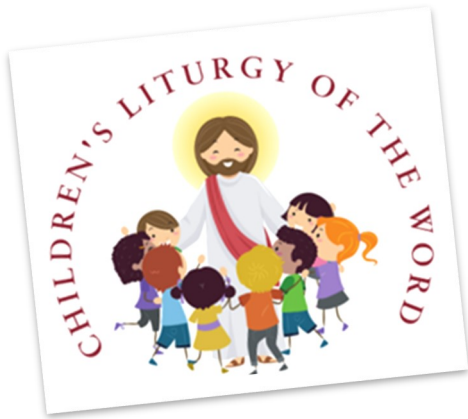

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD RESUMES SEPTEMBER 1, 2024. This program is an engaging and age-appropriate way for children, ages 5-9, to experience the joy of knowing God through his Word. CLW enables kids to enter dialogue with the Scriptures, explore their faith, and learn Catholic values while making meaningful connections with the readings of the day. Breaking open each reading helps kids begin to attune their ears and hearts to how God speaks to us through the Bible. Through CLW, we help fulfill the words of the Good Shepherd: "The sheep follow him because they know his voice."

Our parish offers Children's Liturgy of the Word in conjunction with the 9:00 a.m. Sunday mass. After the opening rites, the children are invited to go downstairs for CLW. They return to their families during the offertory. Faith-filled adults help lead the Children's Liturgy of the Word.
