- LEAGUE LENGTH:** 8 weeks
- FORMAT:** 4-on-4, Half-Court
- REGISTRATION FEE:** \$65 per player Includes SHAC facility rental, court manager, and player T-shirt uniform

- GAME DAYS:** To be determined – Friday evenings or Saturday afternoons/early evenings
- SEASON DATES:** To be determined, with the season expected to begin in early to mid-November, in conjunction with the other MQH basketball leagues.

WHAT EACH WEEK LOOKS LIKE

- 30 MINUTES OF PRACTICE** – Teams will work on age-appropriate fundamentals such as dribbling, passing, shooting, spacing, and teamwork.
- 30 MINUTES OF SCRIMMAGE/GAME PLAY** – Players will have an opportunity to put those skills into action in a fun and supportive environment.
- Each session will conclude with a **SHORT GROUP PRAYER** at center court, led by the MQH court manager.

LEAGUE GOALS

- Our goal is to create a great first basketball experience by teaching foundational skills in a positive, age-appropriate environment, encouraging teamwork, effort, sportsmanship, and confidence; and strengthening our Catholic community through shared faith and values.

GAME GUIDELINES

- Games will be played using 27.5" basketballs and 8-foot rims. There will be no pressing or stealing, allowing players to focus on learning the game and developing their skills. Coaches will referee their own scrimmages, while the MQH court manager will run the clock, keep sessions on schedule, and lead the closing prayer.
