Dear Families and Friends,

“The only thing you REALLY have to do in this world is save your soul.” My mother said this to us repeatedly while growing up. I think it’s a good reminder for us when we get so caught up in the chaos of our daily lives. Loneliness is a great poverty; sometimes, a phone call, a lunch together, or an invitation to join your family at mass on Sunday can make a big difference.

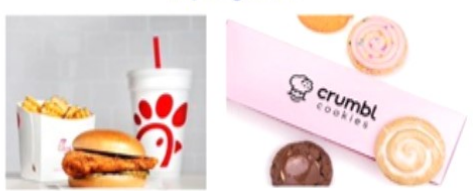

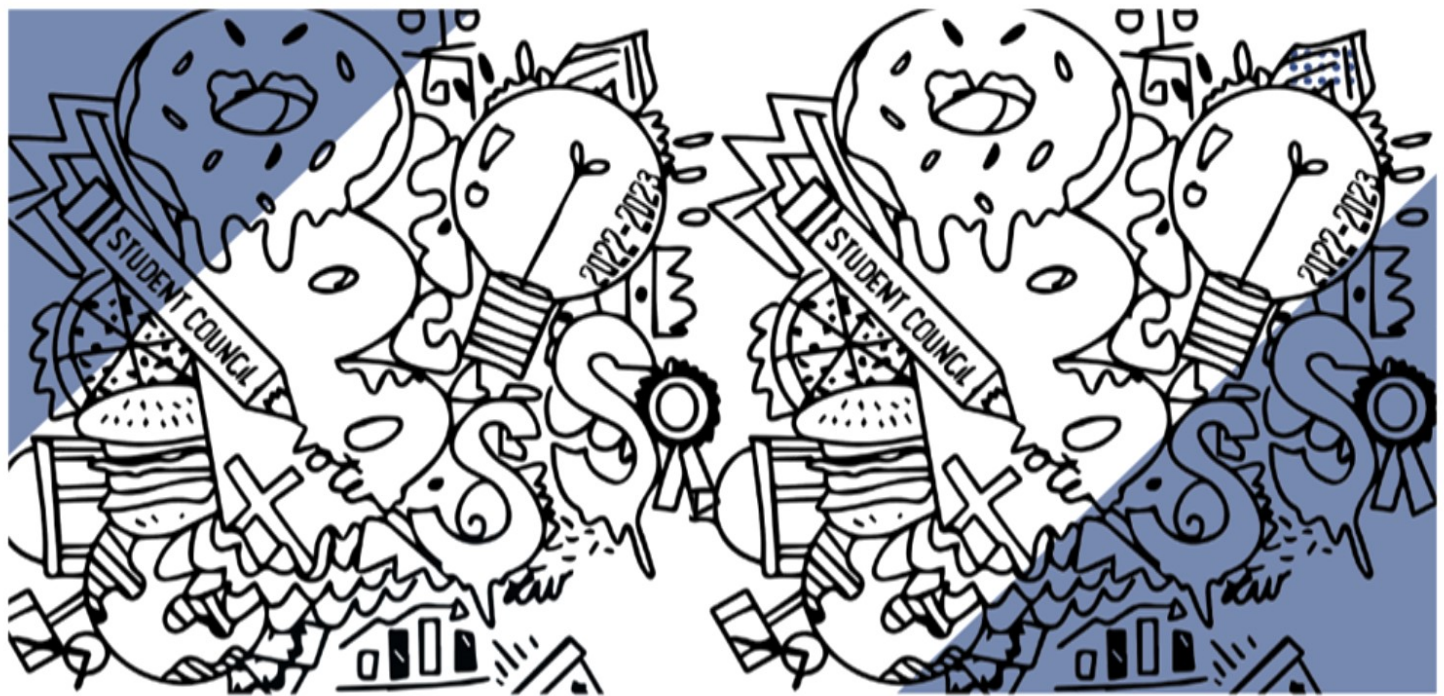

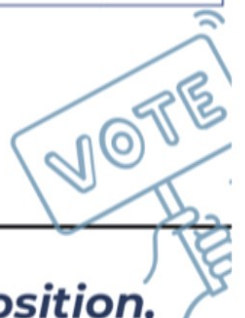
