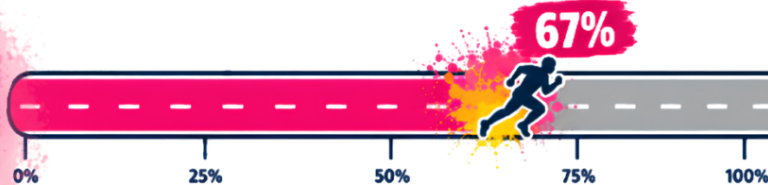

Students may CHOOSE their subject and which medium they work with in After School Art. **Everyone must come prepared with an idea and something to work from each week.** My goal for After School Art is for each student to challenge themselves beyond what they do in the classroom, and they are expected to work on their projects for multiple weeks. Some students may finish only one project, depending on what they choose to work on. Please make sure that your student knows these expectations before signing up.

30 MINUTES OF PRACTICE – Teams
will work on age-appropriate fundamentals
such as dribbling, passing, shooting,
spacing, and teamwork.



30 MINUTES OF SCRIMMAGE/GAME PLAY –
Players will have an opportunity to put those
skills into action in a fun and supportive
environment.



Each session will conclude with a **SHORT
GROUP PRAYER** at center court, led by
the MQH court manager.

LEAGUE GOALS



Our goal is to create a great first basketball
experience by teaching foundational skills in
a positive, age-appropriate environment,
encouraging teamwork, effort, sportsmanship,
and confidence; and strengthening our
Catholic community through shared
faith and values.

GAME GUIDELINES



Games will be played using 27.5" basketballs
and 8-foot rims. There will be no pressing or
stealing, allowing players to focus on learning
the game and developing their skills.
Coaches will referee their own scrimmages,
while the MQH court manager will run the
clock, keep sessions on schedule,
and lead the closing prayer.
