Happy Wednesday, parents!


Today, we are asking for your help to ensure students stay safe on their morning commute. We have heard from some concerned neighbors living on Sunnymede that many of our students that are walking and biking to school are not adequately pausing or looking when they cross streets, specifically when they pass side streets. This neighbor even shared that they have witnessed some "near misses", which is incredibly scary. We will continue to reiterate walker and rider safety with students here at school, but we are asking you that if your child does walk or ride their bike to school, that you have a conversation at home and ensure they understand and follow bike safety habits. We have crossing guards every morning at Burdsall and Idaho, so we encourage students to use those intersections where possible. It isn't feasible to monitor every side street or intersection, so reiterating safe walking and biking practices will help us keep everyone safe.

On another note, we are happy to be able to continue one of our communities' oldest and most beloved traditions, the circle song! Over the next couple of weeks, the children will be participating in a socially distant version of the Circle Song after their masses, though it will look a little different this year. Students will stand when their grade is called and clap along to the music (singing is still discouraged). Each mass is currently attended by two or three grades (for spacing purposes) so just those verses and a few others will be sung by the cantor. Each of these sessions of the circle song will be compiled into one video and sent out to our community! If you would like to attend mass with your child to be a part of the circle song, we ask that only one parent attend (no siblings, if possible, please) to ensure social distancing protocols. Mass begins at 8:15 AM. Filming of the circle song will occur on 9/18 (grades 1 & 2), 9/23 (grades 5 & 6), 9/25 (grades 3, 4, & KB), and 9/30 (grades 7, 8, & KA) immediately following mass.

Thank you for your continued compliance with protocols and for your communication efforts during our return to school. We have had great success because of everyone's cooperation. You are playing a huge part in keeping our kids healthy and in school!


