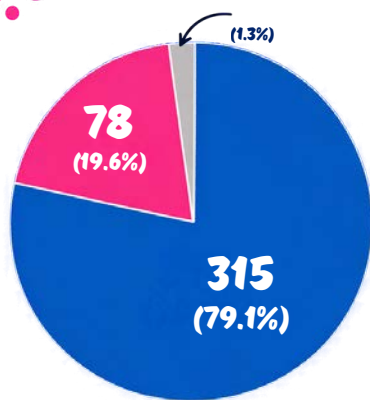

WHAT IS VIGILANCE?

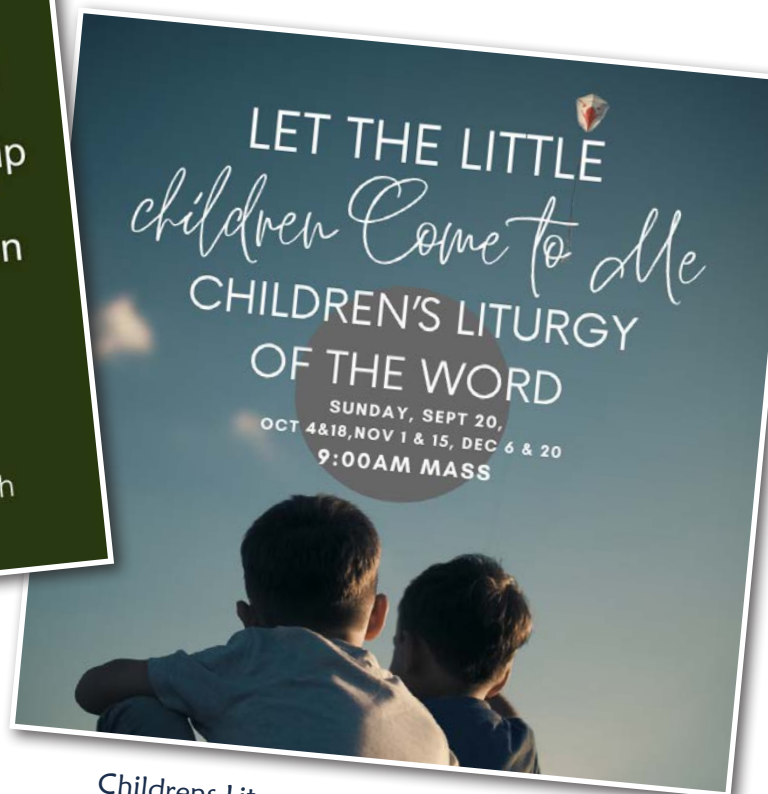
Vigilance is the strength to remain watchful against error, temptation, and spiritual danger.

After School Art is an extra-curricular program, right here at Blessed Sacrament, offering visual arts enrichment for BSS Students in grades 5-8!

Dates/Times:	Mondays: September 28 - November 16, 2:15-3:15pm Wednesdays: September 30 - November 18, 2:15-3:15pm (PLEASE NOTE: makeups will not be offered unless Mrs. Ernst is not at school due to illness)
Cost:	\$160 - includes all supplies, snack and drink for each week
Possibilities:	drawing, colored pencil, watercolor and/or acrylic, collage, mixed media, chalk pastel, oil pastel, sculpture

Students may CHOOSE their subject and which medium they work with in After School Art. **Everyone must come prepared with an idea and something to work from each week.** My goal for After School Art is for each student to challenge themselves beyond what they do in the classroom, and they are expected to work on their projects for multiple weeks. Some students may finish only one project, depending on what they choose to work on. Please make sure that your student knows these expectations before signing up.

Each session will be limited to 12 students and you must email Mrs. Ernst at annernst@bssky.org to reserve your child's spot. Please specify in your email which day you prefer. Students will be accepted in the order that emails are received.

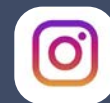
