A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

We look forward to hearing from you at our School Safety Listening Session on Saturday, October 4th at 10:00 a.m. where we will begin with Holy mass, as we should begin everything with prayer. We will then move to the Parish Center for the parents/guardians speaking portion. Individuals will have two minutes to speak about their ideas/concerns. We understand that some people may not be able to attend the meeting due to travel, sports, or other prior commitments. Therefore, we are offering an opportunity to submit written comments with a length of no more than 500 words which will be read aloud. Be sure to include your name on your written comments, and email by October 3rd before noon to: bssoffice@bssky.org.

I'd like to share some information regarding our ELA/Reading curriculum. Two years ago, we started with Shurley Grammar, and we were so impressed with the resultant growth in our students' writing that this year, we moved to Shurley English, which is a broader program that supports building reading and writing skills for grades 3-8. By using the same program, we can be sure of what students are learning each year so that we can build on that while also using the same language throughout for greater consistency. We also continue to offer our students spirals to reinforce past learning. Adopting a new program has meant extra work for our ELA/Reading teachers, so please offer some grace as we work together with this new program.

A reminder that our All School Mass is scheduled for next Wednesday, October 1st at 8:10 a.m. as we have a professional development day on Friday.

A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear Parents,

I want to echo Mrs. Briggs' invitation of September 22 and ask that, if you are able, that you attend a School Safety Listening Session on Saturday, October 4, 2025, at 10:00am. We will begin with the celebration of the Holy Mass, where we will listen to God speak to our hearts and minds, and then following Mass (approximately 10:30am) we will move to the Parish Center so that parents can share their thoughts on school safety at Blessed Sacrament.

In addition, this past week, as Pastor, I have made the decision after lots of prayer and consultation, and with the support of Father Su, Mrs. Briggs, and Mrs. Jennifer Summe (oversees PSR) that we will hire a School Resource Officer (SRO) as soon as possible, assuming we find the funds necessary. We need close to \$60,000 a year to fund this position (monies that are not in the budget). The SRO will be an employee of the Ft. Mitchell Police Department for which we will reimburse the Department. We will have to enter into a three-year renewable contract with the City of Ft. Mitchell, so our total costs will run closer to \$180,000. We are currently working with the city officials of the City of Ft. Mitchell on how we collaborate together to make this a reality, and to create a job description. I am so grateful for their support!

At the end of every school Mass, I ask our children to extend words of gratitude to you their parents, families and loved ones for sacrificing to send them to Blessed Sacrament. I echo that appreciation now... thank you for your support and for entrusting your children to our care so that they receive a passionately Catholic School education and Christian Formation.

There are alternatives to a Catholic school, but there are no substitutes!

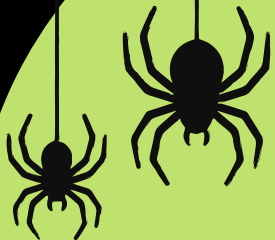
