Who can fill the most Thanksgiving bags for Catholic charities?

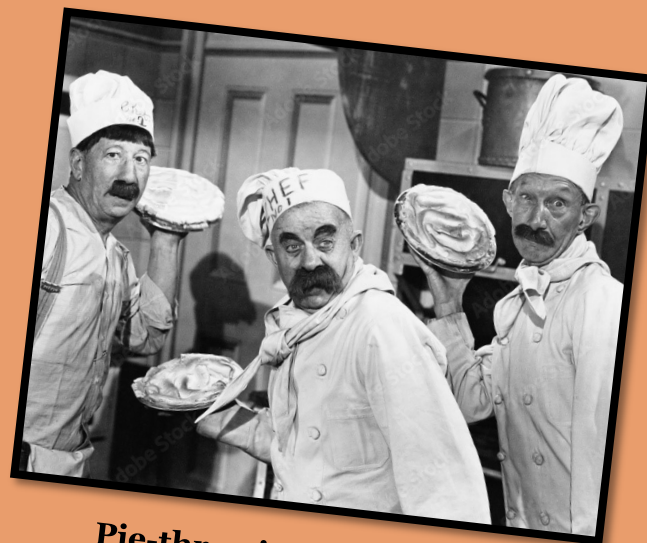
