As a reminder, Diocesan Schools are closed tomorrow to honor Bishop Iffert's installation. Please take time tomorrow to offer a prayer for our new Bishop. Please read on for updates and reminders:

#### **COVID Updates:**

- As of today, one student is quarantined due to a positive case in KA. No other KA students were close contacts due to parent diligence, masking, and spacing.
- ☐ Four students are quarantined due to being close contacts of cases outside of school.

  - Mr. Smith will have already presented a child-friendly version of his presentation to students in grades 4 8 earlier in the week, making his parent presentation even more powerful.



- ☐ Parent/Teacher conferences will take place the week of October 25<sup>th</sup>. Schedules and sign-ups will be sent out in the coming weeks.




COVID-19 symptoms include: fever (above 100.4°F), chills, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea and a new, uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing.



"Close contact" is defined as an individual within 3 feet of someone who has COVID for a total of 15 minutes (cumulative) over the previous 24 hours.

Individuals in the school setting are **exempt** from quarantine if ANY of the following criteria are met:

- they are masked and maintain at least 3 feet of space from the positive case
- they are masked and within 3 feet of the positive case for less than 15 minutes over the prior 24-hours
- ☐ they are fully vaccinated


