A Note From Your Administration

Hi, Everyone.

We shared these updates as an e-mail yesterday, but we wanted to include them here as a reminder, as well. Have a great rest of the week!

Morning drop off

Now that bus service has resumed, we have noticed the additional backups in the car line. Here are some reminders and suggestions to help remedy that.

- The car line does not start to back up until a little after 7:00 a.m. This means that the bulk of our students are arriving within a small portion of the drop-off window (7:05 7:15), which causes backups. The drop-off window begins at 6:45. If morning car riders begin to utilize the entirety of the drop-off window (specifically the early portion, 6:45 7:05), the backups will be far less significant. This will help immensely to reduce traffic, promote safety, and stop cars from backing up onto Dixie Highway. Thanks for your help with this.
- Please DO NOT use the church driveway to drop off students unless directed by a staff member to do so. Those lanes must be kept open at all times for busses. On regular mornings, there are no staff members monitoring that driveway, so it is not a safe option for students.
- □ Please ensure that if you are between lines 1 & 2 when you stop (illustrated in this document), that your students are exiting the vehicle.
- Another slowdown that we frequently see in car line is when parents get out of cars to help children get out. Please avoid doing this unless it is absolutely necessary, as it inevitably takes longer for the line to move when this occurs.

Thank you for helping keep the flow of the morning car line manageable.

Civil War Day

Civil War Day is an immersive day of learning for our 8th grade students which will take place this Friday, October 1st in the bottom parking lot and around church. This educational experience gives them the opportunity to listen to reenactors of the Civil War time period. They will also see Civil War equipment, clothes, camps, weapons, medical supplies, etc. Our trained reenactors will periodically fire blanks from a musket to signal a transition between stations and will also fire a cannon at the end of the day. We like to make the community aware so there is no confusion about what you/your students are hearing or seeing. We are glad to be able to offer a safe and socially distant version of this great event for our 8th grade students!

Covid-19

As of September 29, Blessed Sacrament School has had one student and zero staff members test positive for Covid-19. We do not see any evidence of spread within BSS.


