




COVID-19 symptoms include: fever (above 100.4°F), chills, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea and a new, uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing.



"Close contact" is defined as an individual within 3 feet of someone who has COVID for a total of 15 minutes (cumulative) over the previous 24 hours.

Individuals in the school setting are **exempt** from quarantine if ANY of the following criteria are met:

- they are masked and maintain at least 3 feet of space from the positive case
- they are masked and within 3 feet of the positive case for less than 15 minutes over the prior 24-hours



The Sixth Grade Showcase is an academic event designed to provide a competitive opportunity for Kentucky's sixth graders, who are sometimes "lost" between elementary (4-5) and middle grades (6-8) Governor's Cup competition. Students compete in quick recall, written assessment, and composition.

This year students will be trying out during school hours for written assessment and composition.

Written assessment consists of tests in math, social studies, language arts, science, and arts and humanities.

A prompt will be given for the composition portion in which students will write a persuasive piece.

The top three students in each area will be selected to compete.

Students in grades 1-12 residing or attending school in Kenton County are eligible to participate.
