A NOTE FROM YOUR ADMINISTRATION

Dear Families and Friends,

We are the first school in Kentucky to offer the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd to our students. This year, both preschool and kindergarten go to Atrium where they spend time in small groups learning more about our Lord and our Catholic faith. Mrs. Kris Heck has completed the required training so that we can offer this program. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd employs a hands-on environment with specially made materials. The philosophy is that the Holy Spirit leads the child and the catechist accompanies them on the journey.

“An interpersonal relationship is always a mystery, all the more so when the relationship is between God and the child. We believe there is a deep bond between God and the child, which produces in the child the desire to draw nearer to God. The adult catechist’s role is to prepare the environment, to offer selected presentations from scripture and liturgy. The catechist listens with the child and together they ask, “God, who are you? How do you love us?” The atrium (or prepared environment) is one of the important elements that helps the relationship between God and the child to flourish.” – The United States Association of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, The CGS Approach

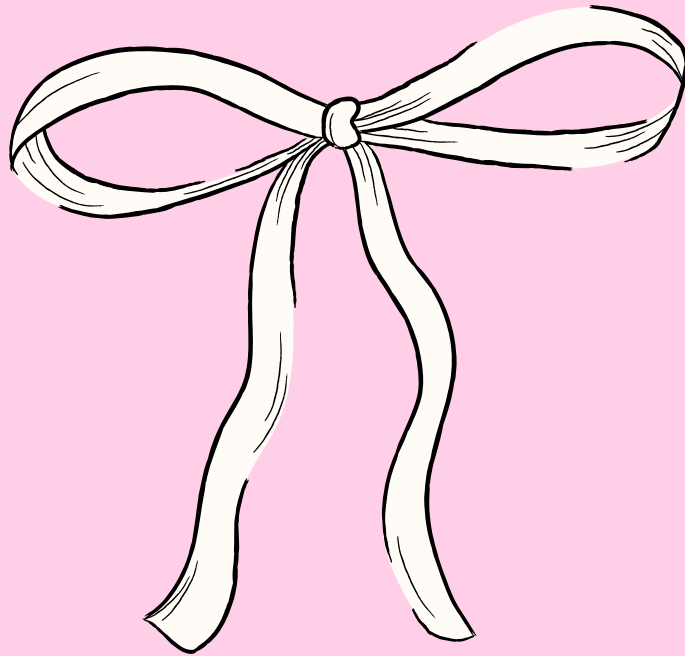

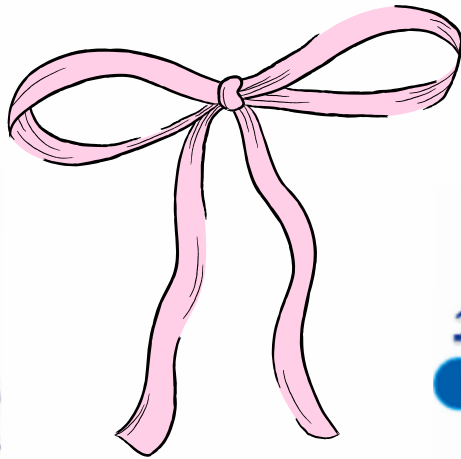

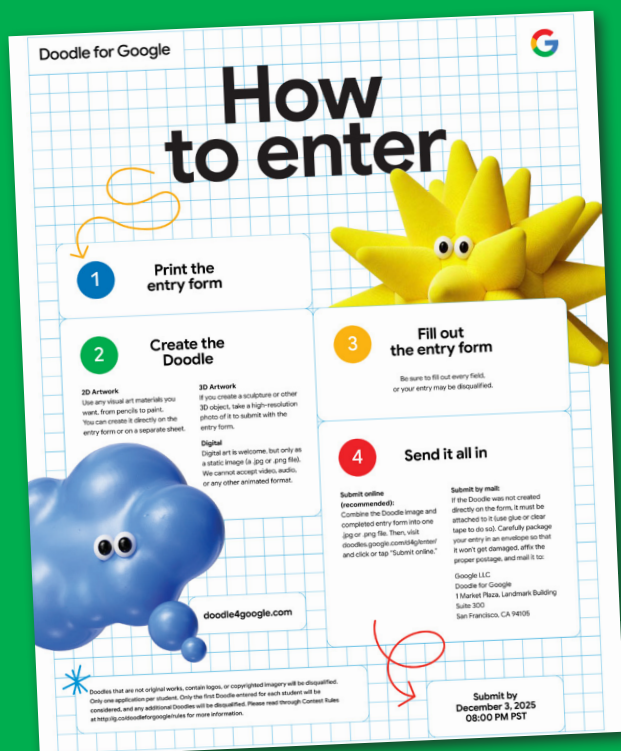
