
Life touch will be offering ONE MORE picture retake day, but it will be held at their studio, not at BSS.


















PLAN A FAMILY OUTING

Treat yourself and your family to an afternoon at the Taft Museum.

An art exhibition featuring Hudson River School landscapes is currently open at the Taft Museum (October 5 – January 12.) **The exhibit is a great curriculum connection for BSS students who are introduced to American landscape painting in the 4**th and 5th **grades**, particularly to the work of Albert Bierstadt, one of the artists featured in the exhibit.



The paintings in this exhibition reveal the natural wonders that sparked the first artistic movement in the United States. The American landscape inspired a loosely knit group of 19th-century artists to create paintings that present nature as spiritually renewing and culturally defining. Sketching outdoors and composing their ideal visions of the landscape in their studios, these artists filled their canvases with majestic mountains, tranquil valleys, enchanting forests, shimmering lakes, and luminous skies.

Centennial Fun Fact

In 1923, a Euchre tournament was held to fundraise money for the fast-expanding parish of Blessed Sacrament. As prizes, fruits, vegetables, poultry, and canned goods were awarded.
