A Note From Your Administration

Dear Families and Friends,

One of our speakers at the Principals Leadership Conference this year was best-selling author and leadership consultant, Chris Lowney. He spoke to us about what it was like to lead in a VUCA (volatility, uncertainty, complexity, and ambiguity) world, a term created by the Air Force. He recommended we create a culture where everyone leads because no one person can do it alone. I see this mindset already a part of BSS. Our volunteer Development Committee has recognized this for years as it has taken on the huge task of raising funds for our specialists (Spanish, Art, Music, STEM, PE, speech, and academic support) as well as other big fundraising goals such as the science lab and technology support. Our Parents Club welcomes new parents into our community through all of their activities and aids our teachers with all of the party planning. Parents Club creates a structure at each grade level to incorporate everyone and make sure each student feels a part of the body of Christ. Our PLC's (Professional Learning Communities) emphasize that these are all of our students, and through analyzing data (both quantitative and qualitiative), we are responsible for making sure each student is challenged and nurtured. Our teacher mentor program assures that new teachers to BSS (both brand new and experienced) are provided a specific mentor to guide them in BSS traditions and develop their instructional practices.

Student Council, Challenge Club, Conquest, Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, MathCounts, Buddies, Choir, Explore, and all of our sports teams offer students a myriad of opportunities to lead. Within each classroom, we develop leadership in our students by informing them that leadership begins with leading yourself. They gain practice through a variety of responsibilities in their classrooms such as line leader, caboose, banker, librarian, homework monitor, messenger, custodian, and electrician. They make choices each day that lead them toward God or away from God, and these choices over time become habits which become character. We are working each day on creating disciples: leaders in following Jesus Christ.


