

This year the HSPT is scheduled for December 14, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. at Covington Catholic High School. All incoming freshmen are required to take the test.

Taking the test at CCH gives you an opportunity to earn a scholarship towards CCH tuition.

During the test, parents are invited to join the administration in the cafeteria for coffee and a light breakfast. There will be a brief information session and a chance to ask questions. The Spirit Shop will be open from 9AM - noon and free gift wrapping will be available for any in-store purchases.


